NEWS OF THE LABEL

Training of counselors in the Indian Ocean

Two CDM will soon open their doors to the public in the Indian Ocean, Reunion CDM, certified in 2012 and the CDM Mayotte recently labeled in April 2013. As with all CDM which will come into operation, training is necessarily given to teams (consultants and back office staff) who will lead the platform in accordance with the requirements of the label.

This is especially important as distance from the City does not allow any new team visits usually done in Paris or near a CDM. It is a training in two time which began to receive these two teams CDM. One part in May longer for CDM Mayotte for an opening foreshadowing from August and a first and shorter training for the Reunion CDM. In September, just before the opening, the councilors will receive a longer training including sessions of scenario and practice exchange with a counselor of the CDM of Paris. Meanwhile, the counselors of Mayotte will have the possibility of a feedback with the founder of the concept Olivier Las Vergnas and Bernadette Thomas in charge of the label. As always in the network, it is pragmatism and adaptation to the prevailing needs of the territory, each CDM developing at its own pace with its own constraints in compliance of the label.

The label and training teams CDM

The objective of general training for teams before opening, either as a precursor or a configuration of full operation is to allow ownership of the CDM concept in making concrete ways of working in a CDM. All members of the CDM receive "training" adapted to the function they will perform in the future structure. For institutional partners, this is at least a half-day presentation and discussion with the head of the label, supplemented as much as possible by a CDM tour operation during the project phase. For people who will serve as the "back office" is in addition to training "general" concept common to all the team CDM training in each case, often based on exchanges including remote homologous with the network. For counselors and reception staff who will be in a face to face with the public, it is not acquiring the ropes because they are already trained professionals but receive a specific training for the reception in a CDM. The duration of this preparation for taking office varies from case. It is defined by mutual agreement between the responsible authority and CDM label. All new Head of CDM has meanwhile a golf grip function and integration in the network, spread over time.

The CDM Charleroi freshly labeled "in project" on April 4

Certified on April 4, the project of Cité des métiers of Charleroi (Belgium) comes from a desire to give a boost to technical, technological and manual jobs shunned by young people. The future CDM scheduled to open in 2016, it will take up residence on the site Roullier of the University of work (UT) mainly dedicated to training in the construction and industry. It will combine students and

adults. Since June 2012, the project can already count on € 30 million released by the government of the Walloon Region and the Federation Wallonia-Brussels. The central idea is to make an integrated platform UT / Chaplains work with training centers in various technical jobs both on the site Roullier and in the premises of Chaplains. In an environment where technical and vocational training are neglected, it is to make them more attractive, especially since they are carriers of employment. Both human and material resources will be concentrated in order to make the most advanced place possible.

The Cité des métiers develop an axis on the construction and industry, with particular attention to the business of sustainable development, in line with the cluster Greenwin based in Charleroi. The place is also known to play a role as a showcase for businesses and promote new technologies. It will also include a space power develop an entrepreneurial spirit and a city of creativity, premiere in Belgium.

FOCUS ON THE CITY OF JOBS OF GRAND BEAUVAISIS

Since November 2011, the date of obtaining project approval label with opening foreshadowing by the House of Employment and Training, The Cité des métiers du Grand Beauvais gradually expanding its service offering. Active on a territory composed of 217 municipalities and approximately 170,000 inhabitants, it has a rich partnership state, inter-, Regional Council of Picardy, Pôle Emploi, CIO, Information Bureau Youth, Local Mission, FACE CAP Emploi, FOLD, CIDFF city of Beauvais, temp agencies, chambers of commerce, business federations and professional sectors, OPCA, CIBC FONGECIF, Partners creation / acquisition of companies, training organizations, CFA, etc.. His areas of intervention is organized around four thematic clusters: orientation, educational training, working change activity.

Labeled SPO on Grand Beauvais Country since May 31, 2012, the MEF / Cité des métiers du Grand Beauvais and coordinates a plan of action shared by all stakeholders. In addition, she is actively involved in the deployment of the Regional Charter Orientation All Life Long initiated by the Regional Council of Picardy.

Every afternoon, in Space and Information Council, Individual specialist advisers welcome, inform and advise the public on the various topics. Upon request, the CDM can accommodate groups (students of continuing education, school, students IUFMs ...). She provides resources, its services and its network of partners to build an appropriate and individualized response to the need expressed.

The Cité des métiers provides a documentation center available on site and a multimedia area, labeled Cyber-base Employment® and composed of 12 computer stations with free access, with specific tools (tests, trades clips, CD and DVDROM) and online resources (specialized sites).

Workshops computer literacy workshops employment (e-CV, image consulting, stress management, 5 minutes to convince ...) through those devoted to orientation (which trades for me?, Identify its strengths), the training (create a training project, seek training ...) or mobility (I organize a trip, I set my radius of mobility), in total, no less than twenty workshops that are provided free by the CDM. Each month, two "Job Info" are organized: in Beauvais, the other on one of the rural areas. The goal is to allow everyone, regardless of their age or situation to discover the sectors that recruit in the country. During these meetings, professional inform the public about their business, training that lead there, the job market, the prerequisites and jobs.

Several "Rendez-Vous" are also scheduled each month:

- Wednesdays of Alternance, on the last Wednesday of each month, partners and training organizations inform the public about training contracts and learning.

- Thursdays of VAE, the first Thursday of each month, the public is informed about the steps to follow to validate their experience by a degree or title.

- The National Police public information monthly on trades police recruiting.

Several times a month, an adviser Fongecif about the vocational training systems: the Individual Training Leave the Individual Right to Training the Skills Assessment and VAE.

CIBC is also mobilized to appointments around the vocational skills analysis.

Finally, to complete the range of services, events are organized by the City of trades and its partners: FORUM (Forum Jobs / Orientation / Training / mix; ZFU Forum, Forum of rural areas, Forum for Agents employment Forum crafts Uniform), or thematic events: Safer Internet Day, for example.

Promotion through various complementary channels. The Cité des métiers offers a quarterly communication medium paper which includes all of the programming. Workshops, information and business events are also relayed on the website of the MEF, via local and specialist press and on social networks. A specific portal Cité des métiers is under consideration.
